On 8-1-2007 the Shelton Police Department received a complaint from the Subway Sandwich Shop located on Howe Av that an unknown female had passed several counterfeit \$20.00 bills the previous night. Patrol Officers through their investigation were able to identify the female and an arrest was made. The female was identified as Jennifer Brennan, age 23, of 33 Roosevelt Dr. Derby CT.

Shelton Police Detectives assisted the Patrol Officers and continued the investigation. It was determined that Ms. Brennan had passed \$120.00 of counterfeit bills at the Subway Sandwich Shop and another \$20.00 at the Howe Convenience Store also located on Howe Av. A search of Ms. Brennan's apartment resulted in the seizure of \$5,100.00 in counterfeit money, a printer and other material used to make the counterfeit money.

It was also determined that the counterfeit money was passed in the City of Derby. The Derby Police detectives were notified. The United State's Secret Service was also notified. The investigation is continuing.

Jennifer Breenan was charged with 2 counts of Forgery 1st and 1 count of Larceny 6th. She was held on a \$10,000.00 bond and will appear in Derby Superior Court on 8-2-2007.
