On October 18, 2007 at approximately 10:00 PM the Shelton Police Department received a complaint from the owner of AJ'S Garage that he had caught 2 people stealing items from a tow truck on his property. The complainant reported the 2 people had run off and he was following them on River Rd heading towards Stratford. Shelton Police Officers responded and located one of the suspects on River Rd. The other suspect could not be located at the time.

Due to a recent rash of crimes in the area the Shelton Police Detectives were call-in to assist with the investigation. The investigation continued and a second suspect was identified. Stratford Police were asked to assist as the second suspect resided in the Town of Stratford. When the Stratford Police went to the residence they were unable to locate the suspect but did locate a stolen vehicle in the driveway. The stolen vehicle was taken from a River Rd business on October 12, 2007.

Later in the day the second suspect turned himself in at the Shelton Police Department.

The two suspect were arrested and identified as:

Adam Pancak Age 23, of 350 Warner Hill Rd, Stratford CT  
charged with Conspiracy to Commit Larceny 6  
Conspiracy to Commit Burglary 3

Pancek was also charged with 2 ct of Larceny 3 for the stolen vehicle.

**Shana Calle Age 23, of 18 Warwick St Apt 1A, Middletown CT**  
**Charged with Conspiracy to Commit Larceny 6**  
**Conspiracy to Commit Burglary 3**

**Calle was also charged with Larceny 3 for the stolen vehicle.**

**Calle was arraigned in Derby Superior Court today and Pancek was being held in the Shelton Police Lock-Up on a \$10,000.— bond.**

**The investigation is continuing and more arrests are expected.**
