On October 31, 2007 the Shelton Police Department received a complaint from a pharmacist at Walgreen's located at 700 Bridgeport Av Shelton of a person attempting to obtain a prescription with a forged request. The complaintant reported the person had dropped off the prescription and would return. The prescription was for Percocet.

Shelton Police Detectives responded. A short time later a female came to the drive-up window to pick up the prescription. Detectives interviewed the female and placed her under arrest. At the time of her arrest the female had her 17 month old son in her vehicle. Also at the time of the arrest Detectives found other prescription narcotics not in their original container in the female's pocketbook.

Arrested was Danielle Lengyel, age 33, of 40 Cherry St, Stratford CT. Lengyel was charged with Falsely obtaining a narcotic, Forgery 2nd, Failure to keep drugs in original container and Risk of injury to a minor. Lengyel was released on a \$1,000.00 bond and will appear in Derby Superior Court on 11-13-2007
