This is an update to the News Release of 2-14-2008 for the motor vehicle accident involving a school bus and passenger car on East Village Road at Vista Drive.

There were 30 students on the school bus of elementary school age. Three (3) students complained of injuries. The students were checked by EMS personnel on scene and released to their parents. Parents were having their family physicians check their children.

The three (3) people in the passenger car were transported to area hospitals. Their injuries were not life threatening. They were treated for their injuries and released.

The operator of the motor vehicle is identified as 17 year old Mary McEwan of 9 High Plains Road, Shelton CT. McEwan is being charged with Failure to Obey a Stop Sign. The charge is an infraction with a payable fine which does not require a court appearance.

The investigation by the Shelton Police Traffic Division shows McEwan was traveling south on Vista Drive and failed to stop for a posted stop sign. McEwan collided with the school bus which was traveling west on East Village Road.
