PRESS RELEASE

On Sunday, May 25, 2008, at 11:39 PM, numerous 911 calls were received reporting that two pedestrians were struck by an evading vehicle, on Howe Avenue, Route 110, in the area of Riverview Park.

Arriving Police and EMS units found Brittany Nuzzaci, age 19 of Guilford, CT and Jessica Massari, age 19 of Trumbull, in serious condition suffering from multiple injuries. Both were taken to Bridgeport Hospital for treatment, with both being admitted in serious/ critical condition.

Evidence at scene indicated that the evading vehicle was a Volvo, and a Police broadcast was put out to the surrounding towns.

Shelton Police later received a telephone call from David Taing, age 33, of Seattle Washington, in which he indicated that he was the person responsible for the collision. Officers responded to the address given by Taing, and he was then transported to HQ for processing.

At this time the investigation is still ongoing and is being handled by the Shelton Police Department Serious Accident Reconstruction Team.
