Update to MVA Route 110 (12-13-2009)

As of 12-14-2009

- 50 vehicles were damaged in the crash.
- 40 vehicles were towed.
- 6 dogs were in vehicles. No injuries.
- 1 vehicle was from out of the state.
- 62 people were evaluated and/or treated on scene by EMS
- 6 people were transported to area hospitals (non-life threatening injuries)
- The crash occurred approximately 1/10th of a mile north of Indian Wells Road on Route 110. The roadway in the area of the crash is a steep grade with several curves.
- Vehicles were headed southbound on Route 110 which is downhill.
- Original accident occurred with a spin out and then a chain reaction occurred with vehicles coming down the hill.

The Shelton Police are asking anyone who was involved in the crash that has not provided the police with their insurance information, drivers license and/or vehicle registration to contact Officer Myles Dupont at 203-924-1544. The investigation is still open as officers are completing paperwork and follow-ups. Cause of the crash is weather related.
