### Police Arrest Three for Armed Robbery

Shelton Police Detectives arrested three persons responsible for the December 13, 2009 knifepoint robbery of Dunkin Donuts located at 733 Bridgeport Avenue. After two month investigation detectives were able to obtain arrest warrants for four people, three females and one male.

Arrested yesterday were 20 year old Mallory Rogers of 103 Utica Street, Milford and 24 year old Jonathan Rodriguez of 327 Fan Hill Road, Monroe. Both were charged with Conspiracy to Commit Robbery First Degree. Both were held on a court set \$50,000.00 bond which neither could post. Both were arraigned today in Derby Superior Court.

Early this afternoon police, with the assistance of State Police and Oxford Police located 24 year old Danielle McDaniel of 41 Spring Street, Derby at a house in Oxford. McDaniel was charged with Robbery First Degree and Conspiracy to Commit Robbery First Degree. McDaniel is currently being held at the Shelton Police Department under a court set \$100,000.00 bond. McDaniel will be arraigned in Derby Superior Court tomorrow morning. The fourth suspect is believed to be in a drug rehab center and will be arrested upon her release.

Police say that McDaniel is the masked suspect who entered Dunkin Donuts brandishing a ten inch butcher knife and robbing two clerks at the store. That Rogers and Rodriguez gave McDaniel the ride to the Dunkin Donuts. The fourth suspect helped in planning the robbery. About \$400.00 cash was taken from the cash registers. Police determined the motive for the robbery was for heroin and cocaine use by the suspects. Police stated that it is unusual for females to be directly involved in armed robberies.
