Police Arrest Woman For Car Break In Spree

Shelton Police Detectives arrested 21 year old Cassandra Campbell formerly of 27 Woodland Park related to a rash of car and home burglaries that occurred in December of 2009 and January 2010 in the Mobile Home Park. On Monday Detectives located Campbell in Bridgeport and arrested her on a warrant for breaking into a residence in the Mobile Home Park on 01-02-2010. During that burglary numerous bottles of liquor were stolen. Police have linked Campbell and others to car break ins in the same mobile home park. Police expect to make more arrests in their ongoing investigation.

On Tuesday Campbell was charged with Burglary 3rd degree and Larceny 6th for the home burglary. Police also charged Campbell with two outstanding Failure to Appear warrants from the cities of Ansonia and Waterbury. Campbell was unable to post a \$6500.00 bond and will be arraigned in Derby Superior Court today.

Police are also investigating a rash of unrelated car break ins from the Bridgeport Avenue business corridor. Numerous cars have had their windows smashed and valuables stolen while parked outside local restaurants and Fitness Centers. Police ask that people not leave valuables such as GPS units, pocketbooks, cameras and laptop computers in the passenger compartment of their cars. These items should be taken into the restaurants or locked in the vehicle trunk prior to going to the restaurants. Police ask anyone seeing suspicious activity in restaurant parking lots to immediately call police and note the license plates of the suspicious cars.
