On January 25, 2012 Shelton Police detectives served two arrest warrants on Douglas Fast, age 47, of 94 Everett Street, Stratford, CT. Fast was charged for two burglaries committed in the City of Shelton. The burglaries occurred on Isinglass Road on November 23, 2011 and Dome Drive on December 5, 2011. In the Isinglass Road burglary a 14 year old female hid in her bedroom during the burglary.

Fast was originally taken into custody by Seymour Police after a motor vehicle chase in their town. Shelton Police detectives assisted Seymour Police detectives with the execution of a Search and Seizure warrant at Fast's residence on December 21, 2011. Detectives recovered evidence at the residence. Fast is a suspect for numerous burglaries committed in area towns.

Fast was charged with Burglary 2<sup>nd</sup>, Larceny 1<sup>st</sup> and Criminal Mischief 2<sup>nd</sup> for the Isinglass Road burglary and Burglary 3<sup>rd</sup>, Larceny 2<sup>nd</sup> and Criminal Mischief 3<sup>rd</sup> for the Dome Drive burglary. Fast was held at Derby Superior Court for arraignment that day.
