### Arrest made in Commercial Burglaries

On 03/06/2018 the Shelton police Department responded to Bahner Lawn and Forest located on Bridgeport Ave for a report of a night time burglary. Officers discovered someone broke into the store and stole several pieces of lawn care equipment. Upon watching video surveillance, a red Chevrolet pickup truck can be seen pulling in front of the store and a male gets out and burglarizes the store. This same red Chevrolet pickup truck has been involved in several commercial burglaries in Shelton from late 2017 through this month. On 03/08/2018 a red Chevrolet pickup broke down on Huntington Street. Detectives arrived on scene and ascertained that this was the same truck involved in the rash of commercial burglaries. The driver of the truck, identified as 43 year old Michael Macy of Shelton, was a suspect in Shelton and surrounding town's commercial burglaries. Macy was wearing a distinct hooded jacket that was seen on surveillance videos of past open burglaries. While on scene it was discovered that Macy's truck was unregistered and uninsured.



Macy was arrested and charged with Operating an Unregistered Motor Vehicle and Failure to Insure a Motor Vehicle. An arrest warrant was then applied and granted for Macy and he was charged with Burglary 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, Larceny 4<sup>th</sup> Degree and Criminal Mischief 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree. Macy was held on a \$50,000. Bond and will be arraigned in Derby Superior court on 03/09/2018. Additional arrests are expected in the near future.
